The Marketing Club Membership Full Terms and Conditions

1. Interpretation

"MEMBER" means the person who is named and has signed The Business Club Application for Membership form for whom The Marketing Club has agreed to provide services to in accordance with these terms.

1.2 "MEMBERSHIP" means the period of time when a member is either in contract or making payments to the supplier.

1.3 "SPECIFIED SERVICE" means the service provided by the Supplier and further detailed in the literature given with these terms.

1.4 "SUPPLIER" means The Marketing Club whose contact address is at Excel House, Millbrook Lane, Wragby, MARKET RASEN, LN8 5AB

1.5 "HEAD OFFICE" means "SUPPLIER".

1.6 "REGISTRATION FEE" means the one-off payment made by the Member to The Marketing Club to cover administration costs of setting up a new member.

1.7 "PAYMENTS" means the charges shown on the invoice.

1.8 "SUBSCRIPTIONS" means the fee paid on each attendance at the club meetings.

1.9 "CONTRACT TERM" means the 12 month period from the date of signing the Application for Membership Form.

2 Supply of the Specified Service

2.1 The Marketing Club (the Supplier) shall provide the specified service to the Member subject to these terms. Any changes or additions to the Specified Service or these Terms must be agreed in Writing by the Supplier.

2.2 The Supplier shall use its reasonable endeavours to provide the Specified Service within the advertised time.

2.3 The Supplier may at any time without notifying the Member make any changes to the Specified Service which are necessary to comply with any safety or other statutory requirements, or which do not materially affect the nature or quality of the Specified Service.

3 Agreement to these Terms

When applying for membership of The Marketing Club the Member agrees to be bound by The Marketing Club's Membership Terms and Conditions.

4 Contract Term

4.1 Membership of The Marketing Club holds a Contract Term of a period of 12 months from the date of signing the application form.

5. Charges

5.1 All charges quoted to the Member for the provision of the Specified Service are exclusive of Value Added Tax, for which the Member shall be additionally liable at the applicable rate.

6. Warranties and Liability

6.1 The Supplier warrants to the Member that the Specified Service will be provided using reasonable care and skill as far as reasonably possible. Where the Supplier supplies in connection with any agent or third party; such as speakers at events; the Supplier does not give any warranty, guarantee or indemnity by the person supplying the goods to the Supplier.

6.2 Except in respect of death or personal injury caused by the Supplier's negligence, or as expressly provided in these Terms, the Supplier shall not be liable to the Member by reason of any representation (unless fraudulent or negligent), for any loss of profit

or any indirect, special or consequential loss, damage costs, expenses or other claims (whether caused by the negligence of the Supplier, or agents or otherwise) which arise out of or in connection with the provision of the Specified Service and the entire liability of the Supplier under or in connection with the Specified Service shall not exceed twice the amount of the Supplier's charges for the provision of the Specified Service, except as expressly provided in these Terms. This warranty is in lieu of all other terms, conditions and warranties, expressed or implied statutory or otherwise and any other liabilities whatsoever and howsoever arising.

6.3 The Supplier shall not be liable to the Member or be deemed to be in breach of these Terms by reason of any delay in performing, or any failure to perform, any of the Supplier's obligations in relation to the Specified Service, if the delay or failure is due to any cause beyond the Supplier's reasonable control.

7 Termination of Membership

7.1 Either party may at any time following the Contract Term terminate the contract by written notice to the other and by immediate written notice if the other commits any material breach of these Terms.

8 General

8.1 A notice required or permitted to be given by either party to the other under these Terms shall be in Writing addressed to the other party at its contact office or such other address as my at the relevant time have been notified pursuant to this provision to the party giving the notice.

8.2 No failure or delay by either party in exercising any of its rights under the Terms shall be deemed to be a waiver of that right, and no waiver by either party of any breach of the Terms by the other shall be considered as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or any other provision.

8.3 If any provision of these Terms is held by any court or other competent authority to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part, the validity of the other provisions of these Terms and the remainder of the provision in question shall not be affected.

8.4 English law shall apply to this Agreement, and the parties agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.

8.5 Membership of The Club is based at an individual, not company level. An annual membership fee is payable for each individual who attends The Marketing Club events. In the event that the nominated individual leaves the company's employment, the company may nominate, in writing, a different individual **but only one change can occur in any 12 month membership period.**

8.6 Code of Conduct

As a Member of The Marketing Club, a Member agrees to conduct themselves in a professional and business like manner, treating other members with respect at all times. If a complaint is received about any Member's behaviour, we reserve the right to suspend membership. If a member is asked to leave The Marketing Club, then their membership becomes null and void.

8.10 Refusal of Membership. The Marketing Club reserves the right to refuse membership for any reason at the sole discretion of the founding partners.

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
